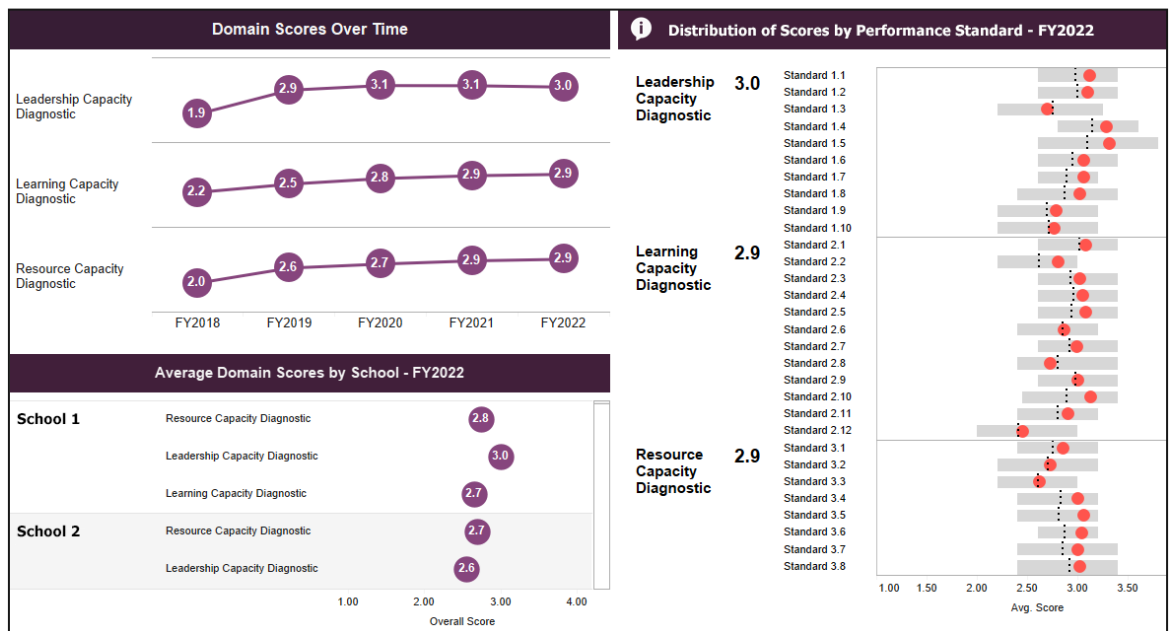
Measurable growth for Catholic schools

Since 2018, scores have increased significantly over three key domains.

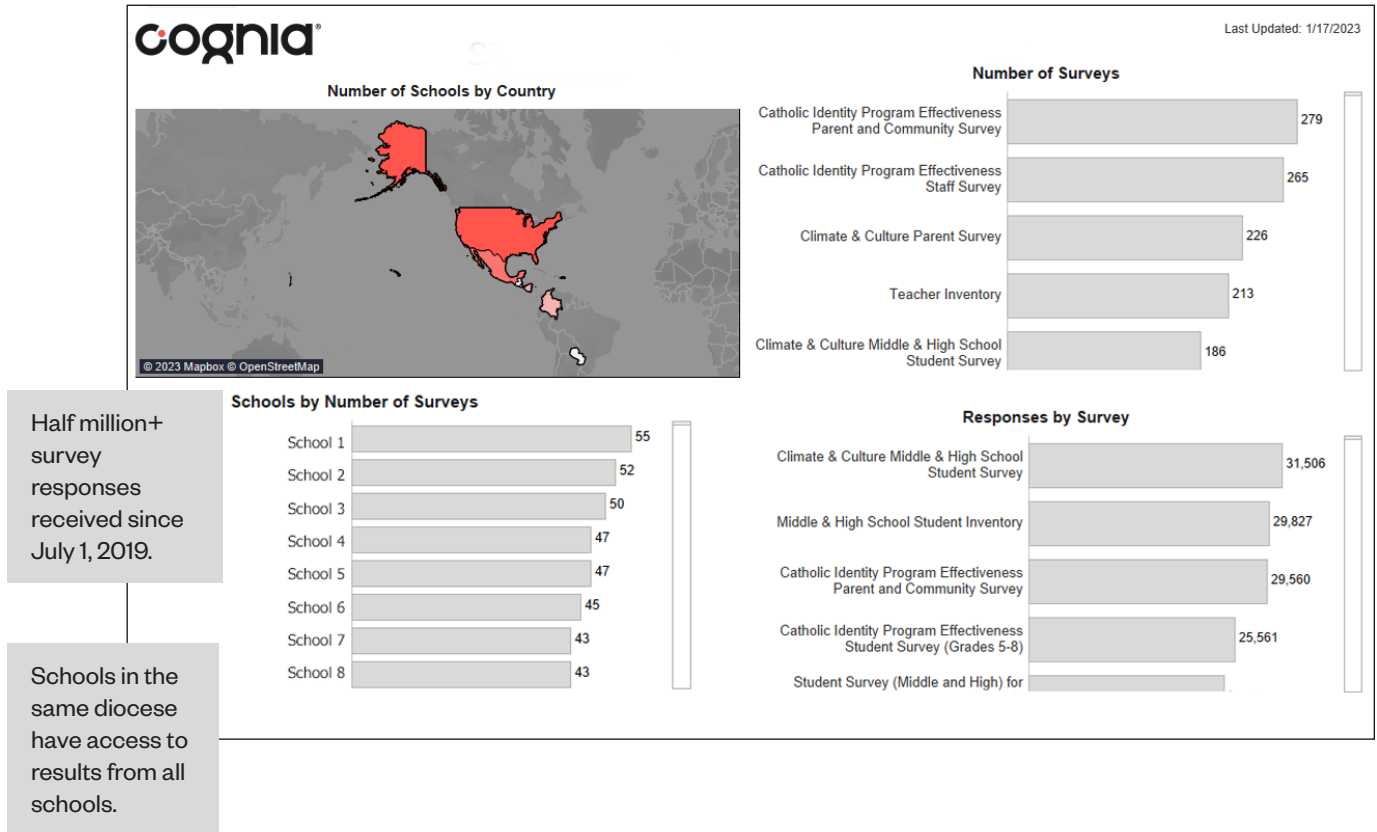
2022 noted a 25% increase in the number of diagnostics administered.
