About the Cognia Improvement Platform

What is the Cognia Improvement Platform?

Our new online platform houses Cognia digital tools to make your accreditation and continuous improvement work easier.

Why is Cognia moving to a new platform?

We're making this change because members told us they wanted tools that are easier to use, all in one place. The Cognia Improvement Platform will provide a more intuitive user experience, improved system performance, and enhanced reporting and insights.

What's staying the same?

While the platform is changing, your institution's accreditation expectations and Cognia's improvement framework remain the same.

What tools are in the Cognia Improvement Platform?

- **Accreditation** modules—Members complete streamlined accreditation activities with easy access to an evidence repository.
- The **Effective Learning Environments Observation Tool® (eleot®)**—this tool has been reimaged meeting the needs of today's classrooms. Instead of measuring seven learning environments, eleot now captures four learning environments. Additionally, it now includes a "not applicable" scoring option.
- **Environmental Rating for Early Learning**—a streamlined observation tool that documents essential requirements that are conducive to the health, safety, and learning for infants through kindergarten.
- **Strategies**—this strategic planner lets leaders summarize offline work while generating summary outputs for each strategic planning phase. There is a new evidence library and system leaders can now provide feedback on schools' individual plans.
- **Surveys**—updated perception surveys are shorter and designed to be administered more often for ongoing feedback and continuous improvement. They also capture more balanced stakeholder perspectives and include built-in interpretation reports.
- **Teacher Observation Tool**—short, formative observations focused on teacher behaviors that support learner-centric classrooms are easy to complete and share.

eProve and historical data

Will I be able to access eProve as my institution moves to the Cognia Improvement Platform?

Yes, you will be able to access eProve through the spring 2027 for historical data. All Engagement Review work previously completed in eProve will now be completed in the Cognia Improvement Platform.

Will I be able to upload my eProve data into the Cognia Improvement Platform?

No. While you will be able to download your historical data from eProve in a Comma-Separated Values format (.csv), you will not be able to upload this data into the **Cognia Improvement Platform**. We recommend you download and store important files digitally.
